St. Stephen's Lutheran School Scrip Program FAQs

What is Scrip?

Scrip is a program that lets you earn money for St. Stephen's Lutheran School and/or for your child's school related registration fees simply by shopping for every day items.

How does Scrip work?

When you enroll in the scrip program, you can purchase gift cards from retailers associated with scrip program (gas, groceries, dining, home improvement, clothes, etc.) The retailers involved then donate a percentage of the purchase back to St. Stephen's Scrip program, otherwise known as a rebate. That rebate is then split 50/50 with 50% being designated to St. Stephen's Lutheran School and 50% being designated by the family to be used to offset registration fees, affiliated high school tuition or donated back to St. Stephen's Lutheran School.

Does it cost anything to enroll in the Scrip program?

No, there are no costs for enrolling the Scrip program.

Who is the Scrip Coordinator?

St. Stephen's Scrip Coordinator is Michelle Hemling.

How do I enroll in the St. Stephen's Scrip Program?

- 1. Complete a St. Stephen's Lutheran School Scrip Agreement. These can be emailed from the Scrip Coordinator or picked up at the office.
- 2. Email the completed agreement to scrip@saintstephen.org or drop off at the office
- 3. Once the scrip coordinator receives the agreement, the enrollment code will be provided
- 4. Log onto www.shopwithscrip.com
- 5. Create your free account by clicking on the "Register" button
- 6. Click on the "Join a Scrip Program" button
- 7. Enter St. Stephen's enrollment code (from step 3 above) and click Register
- 8. Fill in the form and follow the registration instructions
- 9. Click "Register"

What is Presto Pay?

Presto Pay is an online payment system that links your bank account to your ShopWithScrop account and is our recommended system of payment. Each order incurs a \$0.15 service fee; however, it allows the purchaser the opportunity to order e-cards or load Reloadable gift cards from retailers that offer it as an option. In addition, you receive access to the mobile ordering website, MyScripWallet.

When does my Scrip order need to be submitted by?

A calendar will be sent out with order and pickup times and dates. We have been using Mondays as order days and Thursdays as pick up days, but this is subject to change as the program grows. Typically orders are placed and available for pick-up the same week.

Can you mail me my Scrip order?

No, scrip orders must be picked up and signed for.
